Global Waste

Over 92 million tons of textile waste are generated each year globally, according to the Ellen MacArthur Foundation.

Landfill Impact

Only 1% of used clothing is recycled, leading to a significant amount ending up in landfills.

Environmental Footprint

The textile industry is responsible for about 10% of global carbon emissions and consumes a significant amount of water and resources.
